Background

National Health Mission an umbrella Programme of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India to assure universal access to equitable, affordable and quality health care which is accountable and at the same time responsive to the needs of the people and works towards reduction of child and maternal deaths as well as population stabilization, gender equity and demographic balance.

Objective

The Prospective consultant is expected to have the required skills to provide technical support, build capacity, implement and manage programmes and initiative under National Health Mission – Tamil Nadu, across primary, secondary and Tertiary levels of healthcare. The consultant should have a critical acumen to analyse existing programmes, the data and suggest suitable directions for corrective actions.

Key Responsibilities

- Facilitating implementation of NHM-TN Activities across the state by assisting the Mision Director and Programme Officers concerned.
- Monitor the implementation of Programmes assigned.

- Assist in contributing to state programme Implementation Plan for NHM-TN taking into account the gaps, needs supplemented by any findings of facility surveys conducted in alignment with the regards under the components/ sub-components of the planning processes.
- Under take studies / surveys / Operational Research as per the need.
- Provide technical assistance to districts to accelerate implementation of program / schemes of NHM.
- Provide technical assistance to state & districts programme Management unit in monitoring & supervision of the program implementation.
- Identify low performing indicators in the districts and facilities roll out of phase wise plans for uplift of Health Indicators to improve their performance.
- Assist the Mission Director / Programme Officer in appraisal of reports/plans related to various topics/ issues of Health systems strengthening from time to time.
- Support generation and synthesis of evidence on components of health systems strengthening from field visits & multiple technical data sources
- He/she should be a team player.
- Undertake other assignments, which may be assigned from time to time by Mission Director, National Health Mission TN and other state Govt. authorities.

Output

Timely accomplishment of task and responsibilities, regular reporting, provide situational analysis, achieve key deliverables and provide support to strengthen and implement key elements of the programme assigned.

Qualification and experience

- A medical Graduate (MBBS), Dental Graduate (BDS), AYUSH Graduate and Para-Medical Graduate with post Graduate Degree in Public Health, Community Health, Preventive and Social Medicine, Epidemiology or equivalent.
- Previous work experience at the National/ State/ Districts level or in any Government Organisation NGO will be advantage.

- A minimum of 1 (One) year post qualification experience is mandated for Medical Graduates (MBBS) and a minimum of 2 (Two) years post qualification experience for BDS & AYUSH graduate and a minimum of 3 (Three) years post qualification experience is for Para Medical / Other graduates.
- Demonstrated experience in planning and strategy development with policy and / or demonstrated experience in operationalizing health Programme at field level/ working in strengthening district level health systems.
- Computer Proficiency with high level of familiarity with commonly used packages like MS Word, Excel and Power Point, Statistical / Analytical package is mandatory.
- Good oral presentation and writing skills. There should be the skill & aptitude in office process system and forward communications.
- Demonstrated managerial skills and be able to lead a team.

Travel and subsistence:

The consultant should be ready to travel extensively within/outside the state as authorized by Mission Director, NHM-TN. The consultant shall be reimbursed for travel as per NHM-TN Norms

Reporting Requirements:

The Consultant will submit monthly report to the National Health Mission – TN through Programme Officer.

Workstation:

The Place of work for the consultant is at National Health Mission – Tamil Nadu, State Programme Management Unit, Chennai, Tamil Nadu.

Mode of recruitment:

The Consultant shall be engaged through contract mode for a period of 11 months only. The consultant's first term (11 months) will be on probation. This contract is purely on temporary basis. Subject to satisfactory performance appraisal, the consultant will be continued for the subsequent terms.

Termination:

The contract can be terminated by either party giving a one month notice in writing.

Remuneration:

The consultant will be paid a consolidated monthly salary as per NHM-TN norms in the range of Rs.35000 to 60000 as per the profile experience / years of experience benefits, payments, subsidy, compensation or pension. The consultant shall not be exempt from taxation and shall not be entitled to reimbursement of any taxes which may be levied as per existing rules on the remuneration received.

Age Limit: Not above 45 years of age (as on last date of receiving of application).
