**Empanelment of Railway Advocates over Central Railway
For District and Subordinate Courts**

- 1) Applications are invited from interested Advocates as per proforma in Annexure I for empanelment as Railway Advocates for the District and Subordinate Courts under the jurisdiction of Central Railway, covering the States of Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, and Karnataka. The **list of District and Subordinate Courts** for which empanelment is to be carried out alongwith number of Advocates required in each Court is provided in **Annexure II**.
- 2) **Procedure for Empanelment of Advocates:**
 - (i) **Educational Qualifications:** The Advocate should possess a Degree in Law (LL.B.) from a recognized University. Preference may be given to Advocate with higher qualifications in Law or related disciplines.
 - ii) **Professional Experience and Specialization:**
 - (a) Minimum 3 years of experience in practice as an Advocate. For this purpose, the experience certificate shall be endorsed by the Chairman of the concerned Bar Association should be submitted by the Advocate along with the application.
 - (b) The tenure of handling legal cases in the Railways by superannuated Railway Officials, who have enrolled as Advocate shall be considered towards the prescribed eligibility criteria. For this purpose, a certificate clearly indicating the period (in year/month) during which such legal cases were handled shall be endorsed by the respective DGM/Law or DY CLO or legal head of the Zonal Railway/ PU.
 - (c) Consideration will be given to the length of legal practice. Specialization and experience in representing Railways, Government, Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs), or similar institutions will carry added weight.
 - iii) **Infrastructure and Support Facilities:** Weightage will be given to the Advocate having proper and adequate infrastructure including: Office premises, Junior Advocate, Clerical staff, Computer, Printer and internet connection, etc.

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- iv) **Professional Achievements:** The number of cases where the Advocate has secured favourable judgments or orders. Decisions that have been reported/referred to in reputed legal journals or databases may be considered as evidence of professional competence.
- v) **Integrity and Background Verification:** The Advocate's track record and professional integrity may be verified. If deemed necessary, a discreet enquiry may be made with the respective Bar Council or Bar Association regarding the Advocate's claims, conduct, and credentials.
- vi) **Other Relevant Considerations:** The above list is indicative and not exhaustive. The Committee may also consider any other factor it deems relevant for assessing the suitability of the Advocate for empanelment.
- 3) The number of Advocates to be empanelled for each Court have been determined by the Central Railway based on latest requirements. The number of Advocates indicated in Annexure II is tentative. The actual number to be empanelled may be increased/decreased at the administrative discretion, taking into consideration of the volume, nature and importance of Court cases, or any other relevant factors at the time of empanelment.
- 4) The applications meeting the eligibility criteria shall be shortlisted by this Railway twice the number of applications required to be empanelled. The shortlisted Advocates shall be informed through email, from which application is submitted for the purpose of personal interview, along with the specified date and venue, indicated against each name.
- 5) The constituted Committee shall conduct the personal interview with the shortlisted Advocates as part of the empanelment process on date and time so specified for it.
- 6) The committee will assess candidates, apart from personal interview through an independent enquiry which may include physical verification of the applicant's office, library, sitting arrangement, other necessary office infrastructure and any other relevant aspect.
- 7) The list of Advocates as finalised by the committee for each Court shall be submitted to the General Manager for approval.
- 8) The terms and conditions governing the engagement of Railway Advocates, as well as the fees payable for conducting cases before the District and Subordinate Courts, shall be strictly in accordance with the guidelines and fee structure prescribed by the Competent Authority as adopted by Ministry of Railways from time to time.
- 9) All interested and eligible Advocates are requested to submit their applications as per proforma in Annexure – I along with the copy of documents mentioned in point No.10 as below via email only to **lawsectiongm@cr.railnet.gov.in**. **Kindly note that No Offline application shall be accepted.**
- 10) Copy of Documents to be enclosed along with the applications:-
i) Educational Qualifications-Degree in Law and any other higher Qualifications
ii) Enrolment Certificate issued by the Bar Council (Valid and Current)
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- iii) (a) Experience Certificate (Valid and Current) duly endorsed by the Chairman of the concerned Bar Association.
(b) Experience Certificate duly endorsed by the respective DGM/Law or DY. CLO or legal head of the Zonal Railway/ PU for superannuated Railway Officials.
- iv) Reported/Referred judgements in reputed legal journals or databases in matters handled with individual capacity in last 3 years.
- 10.1) All the documents mentioned in point 10 (i), (ii), (iii) are to be enclosed (self-attested) alongwith the applications. Application will not be considered even if any one of the said document is not enclosed.
- 11) Applications must be submitted on line on or before **23.10.2026** No offline application will be accepted. Applications received after the last date **will not be considered**. Incomplete applications and those not fulfilling the requisite conditions shall be **summarily rejected without any further correspondence**.
